To Whom It May Concern:

If you are concerned about insects, such as termites, ants, spider mites and ticks, they do not come with the WoodCarpet, but may appear afterwards. The Woodcarpet production process destroys insects due to the high-speed chipping and pulverizing process. Woodcarpet is made from natural wood with no preservatives or chemicals added. WoodCarpet is generally a neutral material that doesn't necessarily repel or attract insects.

Termites may be observed in WoodCarept, but it is generally not due to the WoodCarpet. It is difficult for termites to bore into Woodcarpet because the pieces are too small. Termites prefer larger pieces of wood that they can bore into.

If insects are present after the Woodcarpet has been installed, our suggestion is to check the surrounding area for infestation and call a pest management specialist who can deal with insect infestation. If you prefer, you can try to mix your own repellent, such as a mixture of vinegar, mild detergent and water. This mixture can be applied with a common pump sprayer. The suggested mixing ratio is 8 parts water, 8 parts vinegar and 1 part detergent.
